TYPE: Topographic; colored with relief shown by gradient tint system.

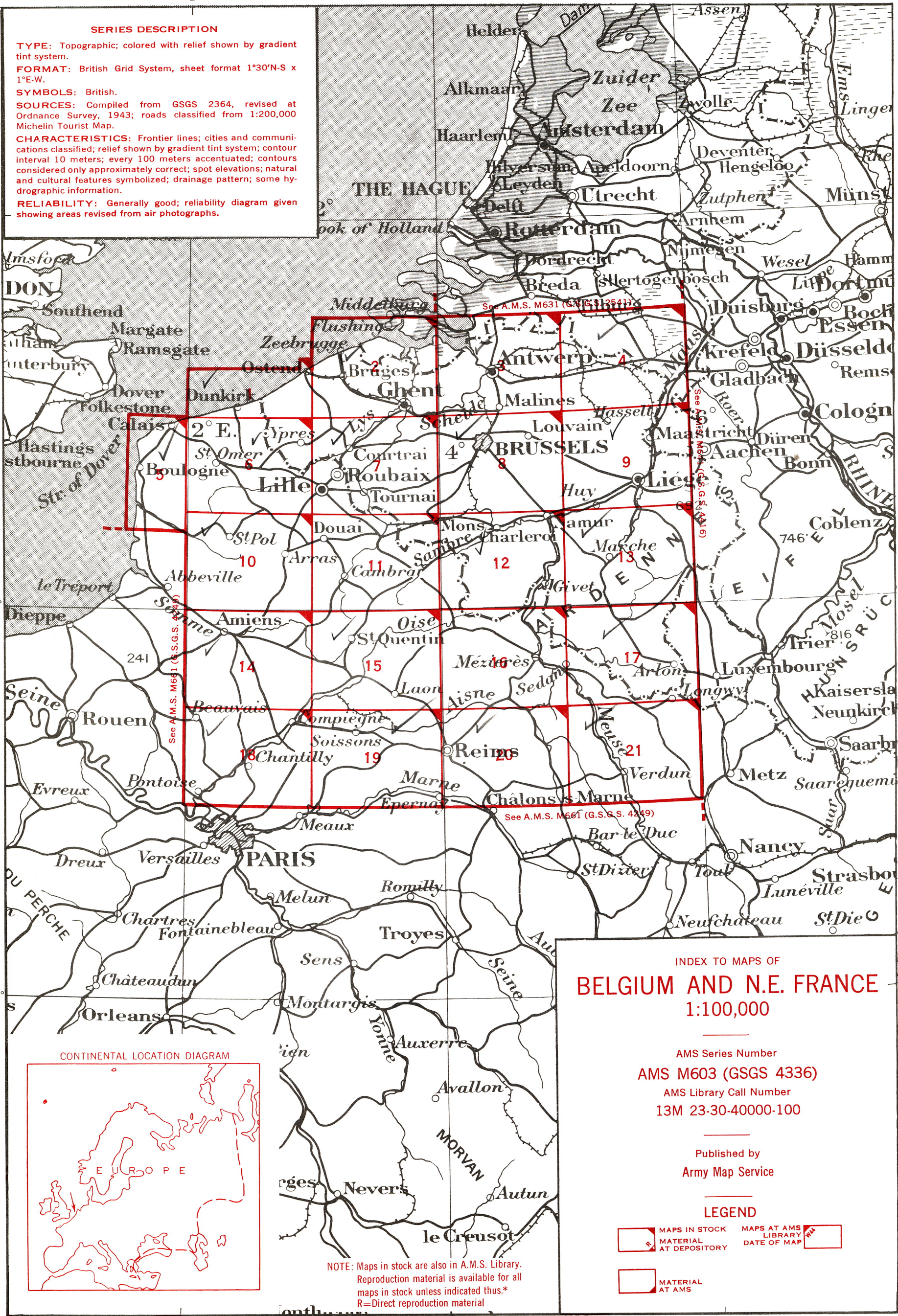
FORMAT: British Grid System, sheet format 1°30'N-S x 1°E-W.

SYMBOLS: British.

SOURCES: Compiled from GSGS 2364, revised at Ordnance Survey, 1943; roads classified from 1:200,000 Michelin Tourist Map.

CHARACTERISTICS: Frontier lines; cities and communications classified; relief shown by gradient tint system; contour interval 10 meters; every 100 meters accentuated; contours considered only approximately correct; spot elevations; natural and cultural features symbolized; drainage pattern; some hydrographic information.

RELIABILITY: Generally good; reliability diagram given showing areas revised from air photographs.
